The Balochistan Environmental Protection Agency (BEPA) visited Byco's Single Point Mooring and Zero Point on 31 October 2018, and subsequent to its thorough investigation, BEPA has advised Byco to resume its sea fuelling operations with immediate effect as of 31 October 2018.
