CPEC's western route

KP treasury, opposition benches join hands for struggle

RECORDER REPORT

PESHAWAR: Treasury and opposition benches except PML-N legislators Wednesday joined hands for launching joint struggle for the rights of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and construction of the western route of CPEC.

The house resumed debate on the crucial issue of the western route of the CPEC and going to any extent for the protection of the rights of the province in this regard.

Opening debate on the western route of CPEC, Zarin Gul of JUI-F criticized the provision of incomplete information regarding the project to the house and stressed need for equal treatment with all federating units. He said that if western route is really not included in CPEC then instead of making politics all members of the house should tender resignation.

Meraj Hamayun of QWP said that situation had cleared after the explanation of the Ambassador of China, which is sheer injustice with our province. He said that the resolutions passed by the provincial assembly were not given importance.

Parliamentary leader of Awami National Party (ANP) Sardar Hussain Babak however did not agreed with the suggestion of tendering resignations and said that CPEC is crucial issue, but still there is confusion on it. He said that KPK and Balochistan provinces have concerns adding it is the responsibility of the prime minister and federal government to redress them. However, he was also critical of the absence of the chief executive of the province on the occasion of debate on such important issue.

Parliamentary leader (PML-N) in KP Assembly Sardar Aurangzeb Nalota informed the

provincial assembly that Federal Minister for Planning and Development, Ahsan Iqbal would the provincial metropolis on October 18, 2016 and would brief the CM and other parliamentary leaders at Governor House regarding the western route of CPEC.

A long and detail debate in the provincial assembly on China Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC) and particularly its western route continued for the second consecutive day with Speaker Asad Qaiser in the chair.

The PML-N legislator also hinted to conduct a visit for the parliamentary leaders and

media to the western route to witness heavy machinery working on the project. He said that PM Muhammad Nawaz Sharif is the Prime Minister of the whole country and none of the political leaders could even think of usurping the rights of any province.

He said that the PM loves Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and have visited its different areas and announced different developmental schemes. He said that majority of the 46 health sector schemes would be built in KP. He said that PML-N is in rule in centre while PTI in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and would resolve the problems jointly.
