Submission Regarding Notice for Non-Compliance of Clause 5.11.1(b) and (i) of the PSX Regulation

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to your letter No. PSX/Gen-2149 dated May 14, 2019, by which your honor has stated that the dead line of the compliance towards subject referred Notice is May 21, 2019 along with a notice *Deadline*.

In this context, we submit as under:-

1. The sponsor directors have obtained orders of the Honorable High Court for reconnection of electricity of the Mill, by their firm determination to restart the Commercial production. The Wapda is still not obeying the order of the Honorable Lahore High Court Lahore, for which the company has file the application for contempt of court against Wapda (copy enclosed). Moreover, the company has requested before the Honorable Lahore High Court for an early hearing which has been granted by the Court and the next date of hearing is June 11, 2019.
2. The company plans to boost its financial resources through disposal of its surplus/idle assets in the form of certain plots owned by it and the old machinery. For this purpose, the company has call EOGM which will be held on May 22, 2019.
3. According to the information available through media, Government has strong feelings that some practical steps need to be taken to solve the textile industry problems. But it is possible only when the secure reconnection of Electricity.

It is clear from the above that the company did not make any default in this regard. So it is requested to kindly remove the name of the company from default segment and wait until the outcome of the coming EOGM of the company and case of Honorable Lahore High Court is decided.

CONTEMPT PETITION UNDER SECTION 3, 5 OF CONTEMPT OF COURT ORDINANCE 2003, READ WITH ARTICLE 204 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF PAKISTAN, 1973 TO PUNISH THE RESPONDENTS / CONTEMNORS FOR WILLFULLY VIOLATING / DISOBEYING THE ORDER DATED 22.02.2017 PASSED BY HIS LORDSHIP MR.JUSTICE ALI AKBAR QURESHI J IN CR NO.3041/2013.

Respectfully Sheweth:

1. That, the addresses given in the head note of this petition are correct for the purpose of service of the parties.
2. That, the concise facts leading to the institution of instant contempt petition are that the petitioner Mills was working / functioning property since its inauguration, but on 22.09.1997 the respondent authorities issued an illegal electric bill amounting to Rs.98,39,614/- against petitioners Industrial Connection having reference No.1613-2102300-3-U under tariff B-3 with 1261 KW sanctioned load. Excerpt of the matter is that metering equipment in wake of electricity supply of the petitioner mill was installed inside a separate room built in accordance with the specification of relevant provisions of electric rules, having independent access of respondent LESCO authorities duly

enclosed with the welded Anti Theft Box in foul proof system and lock keys were kept by the execution Engineer LESCO /WAPDA who used to take note the reading of the meter on monthly basis. That the LESCO authorities leveled fake, bogus, concocted allegation of theft upon petitioner mill and on the basis of same lodged an FIR 482/97 u/s 39-A of Electricity Act 1910, which was latterly found fake by the special judicial Magistrate WAPDA vide order dated 16.06.1998.

That the petitioner challenged the vires of impugned Electric bill of an exorbitant amount through a suit in civil court which was dismissed vide judgment and decree dated 01.12.2012, the petitioner preferred and appeal before ADJ Sheikhupura which was accepted and the suit was decreed vide order dated 21.09.2013.

4. That, the respondent LESCO authorities challenged the judgment and decree passed by the ADJ Sheikhpura through civil revision No.3041/2013 before this Hon'ble court.

5. That this Hon'ble court vide judgment / order dated 22.02.2017 disposed of the civil revision petition with the direction to respondents / LESCO/WAPDA authorities to restore the electricity connection of the petitioner / respondent Mill in accordance with rules and regulations as the petitioner Mill has already deposited the impugned electric bill in court under protest. The copy of order is attached as **Annexure-A.**

6. That the petitioner moved an application dated 22.02.2018 before the contemnors / respondents for implementation of order dated 22.02.2017 passed by this Hon'ble court, for restoration of Electric connection at petitioners Mill premises. The copy of application alongwith report of



XEN/Deputy manager operation, LESCO Ltd Rular Division Sheikhpura are attached as **Annexure-B to E.**

7. That the respondent / contemnors disobeyed, disrespected the order of this Hon'ble court by denying the reconnection to the petitioner Mill, rather than to pass an order of re connection at Mill as per clause (C) of reconnection policy laid down in chapter 8 of the LESCO consumer service Manual, issued an order dated 08.08.2018 entailing heavy cost of payment liable to be paid by the petitioner which is impugned and not sustainable, ad the same is issued against the reconnection policy just to defeat the order passed by this Hon'ble court thus they have committed contempt of court order. The copy of order dated 08.08.2018 is attached for kind perusal as **Annexure-F.**
