**Subject: Gazette of Pakistan - S.R.O. 1017(I)/2009**

Enclosed please find for appropriate action, three (03) copies of the updated Gazette of Pakistan Statutory Notification S.R.O. No. 1017(I)/2009 dated 4 December 2009 regarding freezing of funds and other resources of individuals and entities included in the UN 1267 Committee's Consolidated List. The S.R.O. updates our previous Gazette Notification No. 990(I)/2009 dated 18 November 2009 and covers the changes made in the Consolidated List by the Al-Qaida and Taliban Sanctions Committee of the United Nations Security Council on 3 December 2009.

2. In pursuance of UN Security Council Resolution Nos. 1267(1999) and its subsequent resolutions, including UNSC resolution 1735 (2006), SROs are issued by the Government of Pakistan whenever the Consolidated List maintained by the 1267 Sanctions Committee is updated and provide legal cover for implementing sanction measures under Security Council Resolutions. These sanctions are overseen by the Al-Qaida and Taliban Sanctions Committee which has been established pursuant to paragraph 6 of resolution 1267 (1999). The targeted individuals and entities are placed on the Consolidated List.

3. By resolutions 1267 (1999), 1333 (2000), 1373 (2001), 1390 (2002), as reiterated in resolutions 1455 (2003), 1526 (2004), 1617 (2005), 1735 (2006) and 1822 (2008), the Security Council has obliged all States:

- a. to freeze without delay the funds and other financial assets or economic resources, including funds derived from property owned or controlled directly or indirectly
- b. to prevent the entry into or the transit through their territories
- c. to prevent the direct or indirect supply, sale, or transfer of arms and related material, including military and paramilitary equipment, technical advice, assistance or training related to military activities, with regard to
